Parents and Guardians of USD 439 Students,

In recent days we have seen some positive COVID-19 cases in our buildings. This has caused many of our students to undergo a mandatory quarantine per the Harvey County Health Department. This is similar to what some area schools have seen recently. Beginning Thursday, September 23rd USD 439 will begin remote learning for any student who is out due to a COVID related absence.

Preschool-1st grade students will have packets to complete, along with a remote meeting time once daily.

2nd-6th grade students will be given a schedule with remote times for core subjects.

- Elementary teachers will contact parents/guardians with remote scheduled/details.
- Devices and materials will be available to pick up when needed.

7th-12th graders should plan to remote into each class daily, following their regular schedule.

- Secondary teachers will contact students through their school email with remote details as needed.
 - Students can also reach out to their teachers through email if they have any questions
- 7th/8th graders will begin taking their Chromebook home starting 9-22-21.
- If a student is fully vaccinated and parents/guardians are willing to share those records, please send them to our school nurse, Mrs. Mosiman, at mmosiman@usd439.com.
