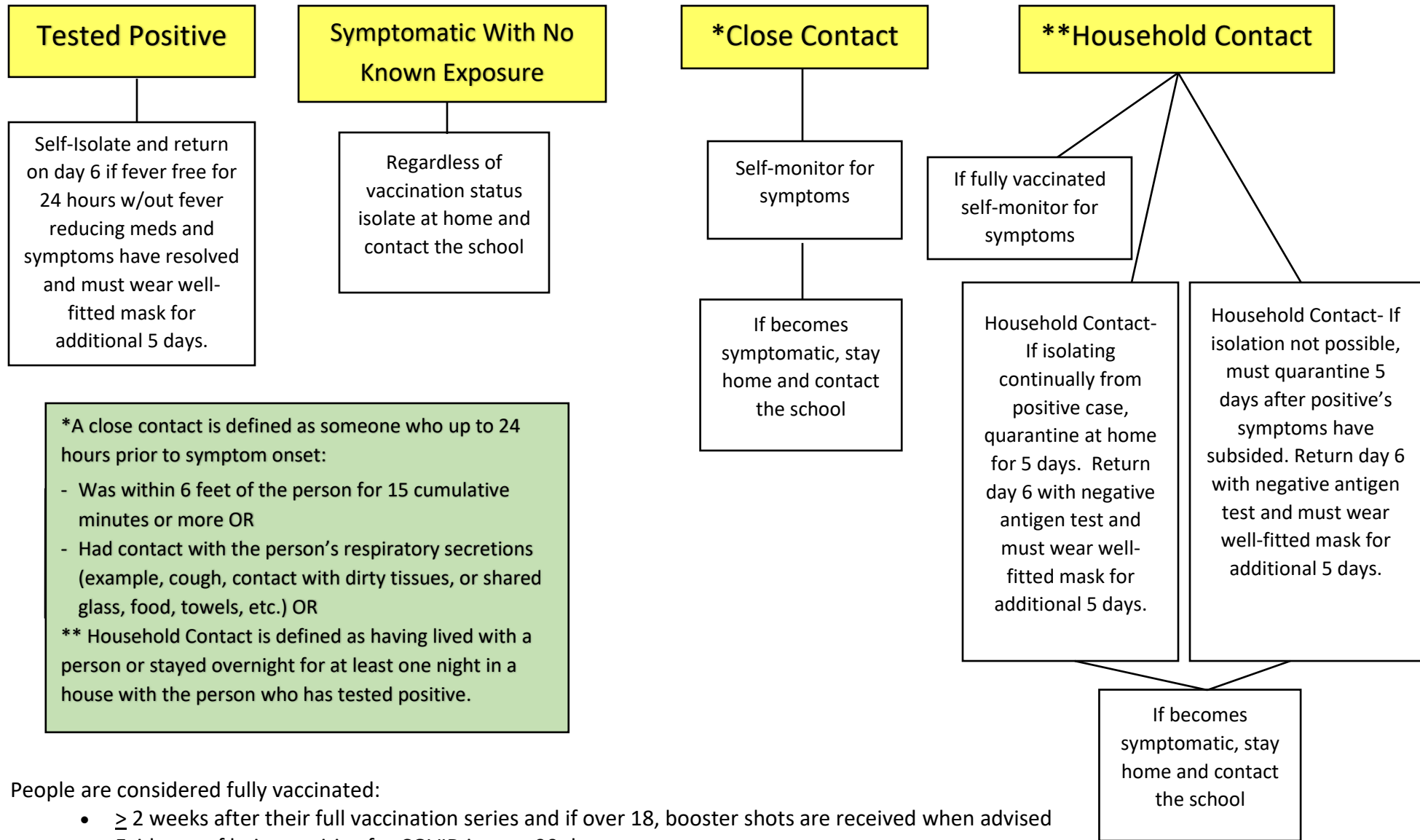


COVID Case Protocol – USD 439



*A close contact is defined as someone who up to 24 hours prior to symptom onset:

- Was within 6 feet of the person for 15 cumulative minutes or more OR
- Had contact with the person's respiratory secretions (example, cough, contact with dirty tissues, or shared glass, food, towels, etc.) OR

** Household Contact is defined as having lived with a person or stayed overnight for at least one night in a house with the person who has tested positive.

People are considered fully vaccinated:

- ≥ 2 weeks after their full vaccination series and if over 18, booster shots are received when advised
- Evidence of being positive for COVID in past 90 days.

**Faculty/students are considered unvaccinated until evidence of vaccination and/or evidence of having COVID disease is provided.
